Rural Arts Initiative Evaluator Position

The Alaska Arts Education Consortium is recruiting a Project Evaluator for the Rural Arts Initiative (RAI).

The long-range goal of the RAI is to expand arts access, equity, and quality for Alaskan rural students by increasing the competence and confidence of educators to integrate the arts more fully.

The evaluator must have the following qualifications:

- familiarity with and dedication to arts education for students in rural Alaska
- writing and media skills to share RAI progress statewide and with funding sources
- personal computer/technology, and the ability to communicate via varied platforms/vehicles
- availability to travel to Anchorage convenings and annual visits to participating rural communities as appropriate in years 2 and 3

The evaluator's Essential Functions will include:

1. Work closely with AAEC Executive Director, project coordinator, and RAI oversight committee
2. Facilitate completion of the Alaska Arts Education Continuum with RAI representatives
3. Support the development of a multi-year, multi-dimensional Arts and Culture Action Plan with each district, and compare changes over time
4. Contribute to the coordinator's monthly progress reports to the AAEC Board of Directors
5. Develop an array of evaluation tools for workshops/in-services, and site visits in the five districts
6. Produce annual report documenting the progress of project activities in each district
