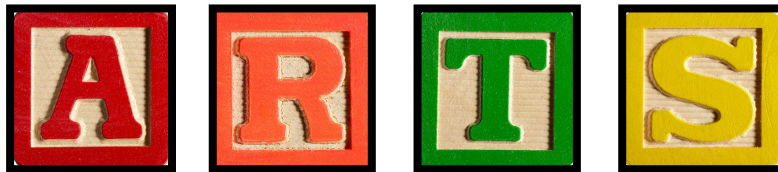


Kodiak Science, Literacy & the
